Dear Parents/Carers,

I understand some parents may have queries/concerns regarding the acceptable type of swim wear for children to wear in Swim School.

I have attached below some examples of acceptable/unacceptable swim wear, which I am hoping will show you the difference in swimming shorts.

Board shorts are the knee length or below baggy shorts (like surfer shorts). There have been cases (not our swim school) whereby the shorts have been so loose on the legs that other children have got their hands caught on the shorts and dragged both children under the water; it is therefore a health and safety issue. They also become heavy when wet and can restrict movement of weaker swimmers.

I hope this will clear up any confusion caused, we do not wish to exclude any child from swimming with us and we do value your custom.
